

3. NEW BUSINESS

3.1 DISCUSSION CONCERNING: Planning of Future City Events and Activities

Assistant to the City Administrator Abbey Anderson opened the discussion by providing an overview of the upcoming events included in the City's Spring Event Series. She outlined the scheduled Movie in the Park events, noting that the first event will take place on March 20th featuring a showing of *The Goonies*, followed by an April 24th showing of *Zootopia*, and concluding on May 15th with a showing of *National Treasure*. Ms. Anderson also reviewed the Music in the Park lineup, which includes a performance by the Texas Miles Band, a country music group, on April 10th, and a performance by The Reverb Cartel Band, a rock and roll group, on May 1st.

Ms. Anderson informed the Board that a sign-up sheet would be made available for members who wish to volunteer and assist with the upcoming events, encouraging participation and

support to ensure the success of each program. The Board then engaged in further discussion, sharing ideas and suggestions for enhancing future events, including potential themes, activities, and opportunities to increase community engagement. Additionally, members discussed the planning timeline for larger annual events later in the year, such as the Tree Lighting, emphasizing the importance of early coordination and scheduling of Board meetings to facilitate effective preparation and execution.

Member Pokorski motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:51 p.m., and Member Uffhausen seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
